



For the department stores-8


For the individual shops-3

This dial shows the total deprivation of the people who live in the vicinity of GHS! It shows, as you can see, that Guildford registers very near 'Least' on an overall scale, this shows that the town as a whole, has a very low rate of deprivation, which means we have good services, education and income. These three dials are Guildford's best topics – they show education, income and health – all very important to daily life in today's society.
