Dubai at a glance

Dubai is one of seven states that make up the United Arab Emirates.

The population of Dubai is 1 million (90% are expatriates)

Ruled by a Sheikh.

Hot and dry. Outside the city it is desert

Timeline:

- 18th century Fishing / pearl village
- 19th / 20th century Trading partner with Iran and India Centre for gold smuggling until 1990s
- 1960 population reached 20,000
- 1966 Oil discovered.

Huge increase in wealth used to develop Dubai with modern roads schools and hospitals, and superb communications and transport facilities. No taxes!

2006 population reached 1.1 million. Oil only accounts for 3% of total income. Economy has been diversified towards tourism and service industries
