The core purpose of the subject leader is to provide professional leadership which secures good quality teaching and improved standards for all pupils.

Provides leadership and direction		
Provides management and organisation		
Secures high standards of teaching and learning		
Plays a major role in the development of policy and practice		
 Ensures that practices: - improve the quality of education provided - meet the needs and aspirations of all pupils - raise standards of achievement 		
Supports, guides and motivates teachers and other adults		
 Evaluates: - the effectiveness of teaching and learning - the subject curriculum - progress towards targets for staff and pupils 		
Monitors the subject		
Identifies needs of his/her subject		
Considers subject needs in relation to overall school needs		
Understands how the subject contributes to school priorities

 Show sustained improvement in knowledge, understanding and skills 		
 Understand the key ideas of the subject 		
 Show improvement in literacy, numeracy and information technology skills 		
Know the purpose and sequence of activities		
Are well prepared for tests and exams		
Are enthusiastic about the subject		
 Contribute to a purposeful working environment through their attitudes and behaviour

Effective Subject Leadership Results in Teachers Who	Grade	Evidence to Support the Grade
Work well together as a team		
Support the aims of the subject		
Know how the subject aims relate to the school aims		
Are involved in the formation of policies and plans		
Apply policies and plans consistently in the classroom		
Are dedicated to improving standards of teaching and learning		
Have an enthusiasm for the subject which motivates pupils		
Have high expectations of pupils		
• Set pupils challenging but realistic targets based upon a good knowledge of the pupils and the progression of the concepts in the subject		
Make good use of guidance training and support to enhance their knowledge and understanding of the subject and develop their expertise		
Take account of relevant research and inspection findings		
Make effective use of subject-specific resources		
Select appropriate teaching and learning approaches to meet subject-specific objectives and the needs of all pupils
