

Clues:

- Large numbers of oak trees will die or fail to produce acorns if found to have Acute Oak Decline.
- The oak jewel beetle only lives under the bark of living trees.
- Hedgehogs feed on acorns and have good spiked defences against predators.
- Squirrels feed on acorns.
- Squirrels store acorns underground for winter, often forgetting where they have buried them.
- Squirrels also nest in oak trees.
- Grasses are often shaded by large oak trees.
- Field mice feed on acorns.
- Falcons feed on field mice and small squirrels.
