Location

1000 Nights Camp is a luxury ecotourist glamping site located in the Eastern Omani (Sharqiya) sands. It is far away from other settlements so that visitors can experience some of what the Bedouins have been for thousands of years.

Accommodation

The camp offers a range of accommodation, including traditional black wool Bedouin tents that provide an authentic desert experience. Each tent is furnished with comfortable beds, Arabic carpets, and essential amenities.

Ecotourism

The camp takes pride in harmonising with nature, offering experiences like camel rides and sunset meals featuring local cuisine. It celebrates the rich Bedouin heritage of the area, providing visitors with opportunities to enjoy traditional Bedouin music, food, and warm hospitality.

Sustainability is a key focus, with solar panels used to generate electricity and heat water. Water is sourced responsibly, drawn from nearby wells and supplemented with supplies pumped from the city.
