







- 1. Indonesia alone plans to convert another 20 million hectares of land to palm oil for biodiesel. This is expected to destroy most remaining rainforests, all of the peatlands, and lead to 40 million people losing their livelihoods on Borneo alone.
- 2. Peat drainage in Indonesia is causing up to 5 times more carbon emissions every year than the Kyoto Protocol aims to save from 1990 levels by 2012.
- 3. Soya, one of the prime biodiesel feedstocks, is the main cause for the destruction of the Amazon and other forests in Brazil, Paraguay, Bolivia and Argentina.
- 4. "The grain required to fill a 25-gallon SUV gas tank with ethanol will feed one person for a year. The grain it takes to fill the tank every two weeks over a year will feed 26 people." Lester Brown.
