- 5. Please select relevant topics for your paper or poster from the list. If none apply, please select 'Annual Conference 2025' only.
- 6. Please skip the pages of additional questions for 'Panel (organised session) convenors' and 'Panel (organised session) paper contributors' - leave the answers blank.
- You will be asked to select whether you would like to be considered for an in-person or online session. Please note that we reserve the right to move individual papers to an online format to ensure session viability.
