The speech given by **George Magnus** contains a good overview of the statistics of Britain's changing population structure and could be used as a stand alone starter. Throughout his speech he makes reference to a number of economic, social and political causes and consequences and asking students to identify these could develop their literacy skills.

Government report

The event was used as a launch pad for a government response to Britain's changing society. The report could be given out to students to précis or students could be asked to produce a summary grid of causes, consequences and possible solutions.
