General Teaching Ideas

1. Using Media Clip Q4 Mark

The [video clip](#) could be shown to introduce a piece of homework. Mark, a sixth form student, poses a question about the necessity for a citizenship test. Students could pose the same question to a small sample of people and record their thoughts and opinions. In the next lesson they could feedback to the rest of the class including their own thoughts.
