ACTIVITY ONE

- The general trend of the brown line is an increase in temperature
- Since 1960, average annual temperature has increased by 0.6°C -
- That's a rate of about 0.13°C per decade.

ACTIVITY TWO

- A1B the temperature rise decreases more than in A2
- This is probably because the population is decreasing and they need less food and are using less energy.

ACTIVITY THREE

- The greatest temperature rise will occur on the northern and central regions of the country
- This is because of their distance from the sea and the lessening of the influence of altitude.
